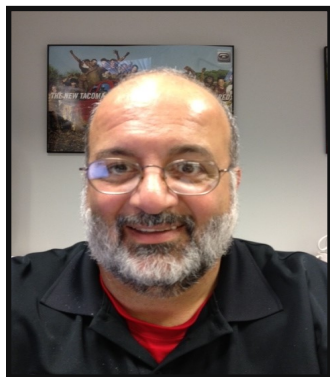

# 11 VINTAGE T-BIRD – MYTHS & REALITIES

Over the years, there has been many myths circulating about Vintage T-Birds. Here are some of the most popular and the answers to them.

**MTYH #1: A “GOLD ROOF” ‘60 Hardtop was offered with 2,536 being produced.**

**Reality #1:** Several journals over the years have alluded to a “GOLD ROOF” “1960 especially an article in one of the first issues of “Collectible Automobile” on Squarebirds, suggesting that it had the roof panel painted a shade of gold. The Golde Company of Germany was contracted in 1959 to provide the hardware for the sliding panel used in the ‘60 Sunroof. Production of the Sunroof was 2,536. A “Gold Roof” “does not exist except for cars that may be modified by unknowing or unscrupulous individuals.

**MYTH #2: A “retractable hardtop” version of the ‘58- ‘60 or ‘61 exists: we heard of one in a junkyard.**

**Reality #2:** Prototypes of a retractable hardtop were produced by Ford to study the feasibility of the system for the four- seat T-Bird. Descriptions of the experiments from the designers published in the book “Personal Luxury: The Thunderbird Story” By Richard Langworth indicated that a “clam shell” scheme which had the front half of the roof fold over the rear, with the assembly tumbling back into the trunk, would not allow for the low profile of the sculpted trunk. The project was abandoned when it became clear that the car would not sell due to price and complexity: the prototypes were reportedly destroyed. No physical evidence has surfaced regarding surviving examples. Confusion with the rear hinged trunk and top mechanism used on the full-size Skyliner undoubtedly has led people to believe that a hardtop T-Bird retractable exists.

**MYTH #3: A Landau version of the “60 was produced for sale.**

**Reality #3:** Again, like the “Gold Roof” and retractable hardtop stories, an answer can be found in the styling studios of Dearborn. Study examples were developed of a ‘60 with a vinyl roof and Landau bars, but it was not approved for production. The idea was utilized for the ‘62 model year, when a padded long -grain vinyl roof cover and plated “S” bars were fitted to hardtops and designated with the “Landau” Moniker.

**MYTH #4: A “California Model” ‘61 was produced with no side trim.**

**Reality #4:** The story surfaced in the early ‘80s in the SCOOP. Claims were made that some 61s did not receive the four spears on the rear quarter panel or nameplates on the front fenders. No literature or physical proof was ever produced to verify the existence of such a derivative. A logical answer is that the cars examined had their quarter panels replaced as a result of collision damage. Replacement sheet metal often is not drilled for emblems when it is used for several years (such as the ‘61to’63run), so that the body shop installing the repair panel can drill holes specific to the cars trim or if they’re lazy, not install the trim at all. This would explain no holes in the panels. Another logical answer would be that someone had removed the trim from a ‘61 as a customizing measure, as is popular with car enthusiasts, and over the years the myth evolved to explain such a car’s existence.

**MYTH #5: A choice of a 375-hp 4- barrel or a 401-hp 3-2 barrel motor was available for the ‘Bird in ‘61.**

**Reality #5:** The only motor advertised for the ‘61 was the “Z”-code 300-hp 390-4v. It was also used in full size Fords: also coded “Z” were a 375-hp 390-4v, a 401-hp 390- 6v and a 330-hp Police Interceptor 390-4v. This confusion would end when the Police Interceptor was given a “P” code and the 375-horse motor “Q”. The 401-hp 3 deuce, introduced in mid-year retained the “Z” (it was dropped for ‘62, being superseded by the 406 “G”).

**MYTH #6: A chrome dress-up kit for the engine was offered with a plated air cleaner on the T-Bird in ‘61-’63.**

**Reality #6:** The factory did not offer a dress up package strictly for the ‘Bird. Intended for the full-size Ford with the 352-390-406, a kit was put together which had a plated open element air cleaner, valve covers, master cylinder cap, dip stick, radiator cap, and upper fan shroud. Parts from these kits could be used on the ‘Bird, but dealers or owners had to plate the air cleaner as they were not offered by Ford.

**MYTH #7: More than 63,313 “63 Thunderbirds were built.**

**REALITY #7:** Author Richard Langworth, in compiling material for his book “Personal Luxury”: states that a discrepancy existed in the figures he obtained from Ford of 2,455 units. This can be accounted for in that they reflect the production of the Limited Edition “Monaco” Landaus and 455 Sports Roadsters, which would have been included in regular production figures.

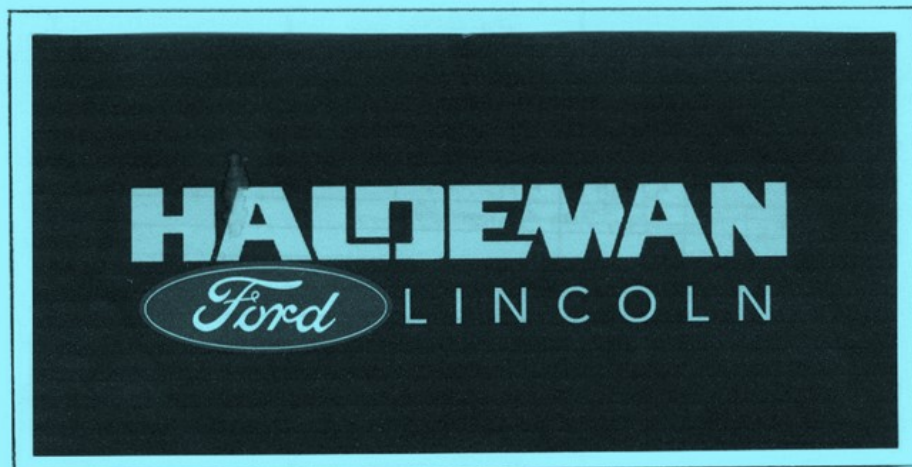
